BYLAW NO 1-18 VILLAGE OF BELLE PLAINE

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLE PLAINE TO PROVIDE INTEREST ON OVERDUE UTILITY ACCOUNTS

The Council of the Village of Belle Plaine, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. That this bylaw shall be known as the "Interest bylaw".
- 2. An amount of 2% per month with a maximum of 24% per year, will be added to all utility accounts once they enter 30 days overdue.
- 3. The rates, charges, tolls or rent contained within this bylaw shall come into focus and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the local government agency.
- 4. Bylaw 5-17 is hereby repealed.
