

BYLAW # 1-19

VILLAGE OF BELLE PLAINE

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLE PLAINE TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPEAL FEE FOR ANY
APPEALS TO THE BOARD OF REVISION:**

The municipality of the Village of Belle Plaine in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited as the Appeal Fee.

SCOPE OF BYLAW:

2. That a fee of \$500.00 per appeal of assessment, be set for each residential property that appeal to the Board of Revision.
3. That a fee of \$1,000.00 per appeal of assessment, be set for each commercial property that appeal to the Board of Revision.
4. That such fees as referred to in sections (1) and (2) above, be required to be paid by the appellant, to the Village of Belle Plaine, at time of appeal application submission. If fee is not received the appeal will be dismissed.
5. That bylaw 1-2000 is hereby repealed.
