Bylaw No. 1-24 Village of Belle Plaine

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the Village of Belle Plaine in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Belle Plaine
 - d) Fire Response shall mean response by:
 - i) Pense District Volunteer Fire Department
 - ii) Any third-party department for protection of person(s) and/or property
- The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the person(s) who receive the service in accordance with the following:
 - a) Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.
 - a) The rates contained within the Schedule A May be revised from time to time.
- 3. The fees mentioned in schedule A shall be payable to the Village of Belle Plaine.
- 4. In accordance with the Municipalities Act section 369 (1)(d), all unpaid fees owed to the Village at the end of the calendar year, will be added to the property and become part of the tax card.
- 5. Bylaw # 1-20 is hereby repealed.

Schedule A Village of Belle Plaine Bylaw 1-2024

- I. 1st Pumper fire truck \$1,200.00 for the first hour and \$650.00 for every hour after.
- II. 2nd Pumper fire truck \$750.00 per hour.
- III. Tanker \$650.00 per hour.
- IV. Quick response vehicle \$1,200.00 for the first hour and \$650.00 for every hour after.
- V. Support Vehicle \$100.00 per hour.
- VI. Refill of breathing apparatus tanks and foam will be billed out as cost recovery.
- VII. One hour minimum will be applied.
- VIII. Time shall be calculated from the time a unit leaves the Pense Fire Hall until it returns. Any time lost through malfunction of firefighting equipment shall be deducted,
 - IX. Third party department dispatch as per the total cost as invoiced by third party.
